Star Wars meets the Mona Lisa! Integrating science and art for boys.

Leonardo da Vinci...flight...rockets...celestial bodies...lightspeed. Our scientist from

Drexel University will be present to challenge the boys in all things Star Wars. How did

the creators of Star Wars make this phenomenon so spectacular? We'll have great fun with Star Wars inspired art and science. We will take a look at some breathtaking photos of the celestial bodies way out there...and be inspired by them to think and create way out art.

Cosmos

Where art meets science...a workshop for girls. Our scientist from Drexel University will be present to challenge the girls to be inspired by all things celestial. Our artist teachers will present way cool, glitzy, glittering space themed art projects. We will study some truly space inspired art from the history of modern art with an explosion of Leonardo da Vinci and Vincent Van Gogh thrown into the mix.

Growing things...growing art....

Branches, roots, insects, birds, and nature...reduce, reuse, recycle.

Beautiful art, beautiful world...

Nature is the starting point for all the art this week, in both materials and inspiration.

Artisans will create artworks using sticks, rocks, fruits, vegetables, as well as traditional artist materials. We will be looking at Earth art -- including cave paintings, Stonehenge and the geoglyphs in the Nazca Desert. We will also look at the work of famous artists like Andy Goldsworthy and Charley Harper for inspiration.

Week of July 25 – 29

Terra

9 – 12 noon

Materials and firing fee \$30

A pottery class with guest artists/teachers, Terra, will explore the many facets of Ceramic Art. Throughout this week you will be exposed to many processes and techniques in creating pottery - such as learning how to throw on the potter's wheel, hand building, glazing and the firing processes. During this week you will exercise your creativity in constructing functional and nonfunctional ceramic objects, while integrating the fundamentals of art in each project.

Week of August 1 – 5

Drum

9 – 12 noon

Ages 4 - 12

World drum workshop with Tony Mascara. Tony will share the rich history and culture of drums from around the globe. Students will have the opportunity to play a variety of drums using rhythm, dynamics, and accents. They will create their own instruments from recycled materials and decorate them with their own art. We will also explore everyday items from nature as well as household items as a means for making rhythms. Learn the dances inspired by the drumbeats from many cultures...students who enjoy creative movement may take part in the optional movement class.

Week of August 8 -12

Tinker

9 – 12 noon

Drafting adventures and The Art of Toy Design

Design fun begins with the student's intuition and imagination. Students will learn how to draw their plans, make models and read a blueprint. Drawing inspiration from surplus materials and natural forms, young artisans will discover endless possibilities in the art of fabrication and assemblage. Some will naturally gravitate to creating imaginative creatures and animals of different specie; others may choose to work abstractly, discovering sculptural forms or inventing a magical product with special powers. Students will take a look at the inventions of Leonardo daVinci, as well as the art of modern day toy designers.

Ballet Intensive

1 – 5 PM

Ages 8 yrs and older.

Younger students may be accepted with director's approval.

New this year is our Ballet Intensive for the serious ballet student. Summer is a great time to improve technique! This session will concentrate on ballet technique, challenging choreography, dance history, and performance quality and artistry. This 20 hour intensive – compare to 5 weeks of classes – will be a rewarding experience for students and will improve flexibility, stamina, and alignment. Ballet students must adhere to the Magnolia Hill dress code.

Studio will provide snacks every day for this class....

Calling all aspiring princesses.... An **art and dance** workshop with a unique curriculum taking inspiration from real princesses and some fairytale princesses and focusing on royal history, manners, philanthropy and kindness. Each day will focus on a different princess. We will dance to the beautiful music of Tangled, Cinderella, Sleeping Beauty, and other inspiring and exciting princess stories, some Disney scores and some classical ballet. Each day we will do a ballet or princess inspired art project and look at some princess images from great artists of the past. Take a look at these daily themes:

On Princess Kate day we will have a wedding celebration. Practice table manners – elbows, napkins, understanding place settings, appropriate conversation, etc. Also, the importance of thank you notes

There will be a beach day with Ariel. Picnic manners.... Discussion of what to do during those awkward moments....

Rapunzel.... Good grooming, eye contact, smiling, good conversation....

Cinderella... walking with a book or crown on your head, good posture...dancing with a prince Proper introductions, giving and receiving compliments....

On Princess Diana day we will have tea at Kensington Palace. Pouring and serving tea properly, teatime manners....

Friday showcase... Manners at the theatre....

Girls may wear princess clothes or tutus every day.

Animate

1 – 4 PM

Ages 7 – 16

Materials fee \$25

A workshop in animation and illustration.

Imagine your own adventures!! Students will try out the basic skills necessary to a career in illustration and cartooning. Learn how to make characters full of mood, emotion and energy. Drawing techniques like color, composition and 3D will be explored. Young illustrators will learn how to make their still images come to life or become “animated”.

We will take a look at some early forms of animation like the zoetrope.

We will have fun making flip books and creating our own stop-action adventure stories.

View your works in a premiere screening and take home a DVD of our class animated film. A perfect class for kids who love to draw.
